In an effort to ‘**stretch**’ the available dollars in this scholarship program, we invite industry to consider a unique opportunity to participate as a . . . **“Stretch the Million” partner** with the Build Dakota Scholarship.

All Students accepting a Build Dakota Scholarship must agree to work in that field in the State of South Dakota for three years upon graduation from a technical institute.

Students with a STM partner commit to work for the STM partner for the three years upon graduation from LATI.

The overall goal of the Stretch the Million program is to add even more skilled employees, to the critical needs workforce pipeline in South Dakota.

In Cohort 4 (2018-19) 60 companies are serving as a STM partner for over 100 students!

The Details!

- The full-ride scholarships supports tuition, fees, tools, books and other required program expenses in the eligible BDS programs.
- Both in-state students and out-of-state students are eligible for the scholarship.
- Students of ALL ages are welcome to apply—this scholarships is NOT only for graduating high school students.
- Recipients of the scholarship commit to living and working in the state, in their field of study, for three years following graduation.
